

## **Call for Vlog-Posts**

The SAP Vlog (Video + blog = Vlog) is a new communication and professional development initiative by the SAP Interest Group at the Academy of Management. Vlog posts are 5 to 15 minute video interviews with authors of work that has extended our understanding of the practice of strategy-making. These interviews provide viewers with behind-the-scenes insights into the origins and developments of the ideas that these works advance, as well as retrospective reflections on the timeliness and reception of these ideas in contemporary discourses.

## **Interested? How to Create a Vlog-Post**

- 1. Reach out to <u>Priya Kannan</u> from the SAP Social Media Committee with a brief informal proposal for a vlog post.
- 2. Reach out to the author of a paper/chapter/book that you would like to spotlight for an interview.
- 3. Download Screenflow or any other screen-recording device.
- 4. Conduct the interview (5 to 15 min) on Skype and record it.
- 5. Send the video to Priya. The SAP Social Media Committee can help you with final editing and distribution of the vlog post on social media.
