

Operations and Supply Chain Management Position Open Rank

The Management Science Department at the Darla Moore School of Business, University of South Carolina, invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position within the Operations and Supply Chain Management group. The rank is open, though preference would be at the associate or full professor level. The start date for this position is August 16, 2020. An ideal candidate at the junior level should have the potential to produce outstanding research and excel in the classroom, while a candidate at the senior level would demonstrate a proven ability to produce high impact research and excel in graduate and undergraduate teaching, along with an interest in developing a competence in executive education and business outreach. Our group has a vibrant doctoral program and an expectation for this position is to teach doctoral seminars and serve as an advisor for doctoral student dissertations. Qualifications for this position include a Ph.D. or DBA in Operations Management/Supply Chain Management or a closely related field. Preference will be given to candidates with strong training in empirical research. Candidates should have an appropriate background to teach our operations management electives. Salary and compensation is highly competitive and commensurate with experience and achievements. All faculty searches are subject to the availability of funding.

The Operations Management group at the Moore School is well known for its research published in the top tier journals of the field. The Department also houses an active Operations and Supply Chain Center, which cultivates outreach to industry and enhances practice-based pedagogical and scholarly research.
