Are you an ambitious scholar with strong commitment to high-quality research in the strategy domain? Are you passionate about teaching and delivering an exceptional student experience in a Russell Group University? Do you have experience in applying for research funding?

We are seeking to appoint a high-calibre individual at the Lecturer (Assistant Professor) level in the S&O subject group within the Management Department of Leeds University Business School (LUBS). The school is internationally renowned for the quality of its research, its teaching, and its facilities. REF 2021 positions LUBS as one of the UK's leading business schools for research and impact power. As a triple accredited, top-ranking European business school, it has more than 3000 students from around 100 countries and more than 200 academic staff. Its work covers the full spectrum of business disciplines, creating new knowledge and teaching undergraduate, masters, and doctoral students.

The S&O group and the affiliated Centre for Technology Innovation and Engagement (C-TIE) are the focal points for strategy-related research and education at LUBS. With its collegial and vibrant team of scholars, the S&O group aspires to become one of the leading faculties working at the intersections of strategic management, organisational theory, and innovation management. The S&O group, and the broader Management department it part of, is an exceptionally nurturing and rewarding place to work. For the position that has opened, we are looking for a colleague who has a promising research profile and the skills to deliver excellent teaching. While we are open to considering applications from candidates with interest in any strategy subfield, we have preference for those specializing in one of the following areas: corporate leadership and governance; corporate strategy; competitive strategy; knowledge and innovation management; strategic management of sustainable business practices and/or diversity, equity and inclusion.



What does the role entail?

As a Lecturer (Grade 7) in Strategy your main duties will include:

- Contributing to the ambitions of the S&O group by conducting impactful worldclass research;
- Applying for research funding on an individual and/or collaborative basis to underpin research programmes/projects;
- Collaborating with others within the S&O group in activities that have potential for high academic and practical impact;
- Undertaking research-led teaching, and setting and assessing examinations at the UG and PG levels;
- Providing high-quality research supervision and training to UG and PG students;
- Supporting and guiding students, providing timely feedback, acting as personal tutor, resolving issues and/or referring to specialist parties, where appropriate.

In addition, as Lecturer (Grade 8) in Strategy your main duties will include:

- Ensuring a track record of publications in prominent journals of the field and showing potential to publish in the field's top-tier journals;
- Contributing towards module design, review and quality assurance mechanisms;
- Providing research supervision to PhD students;
- Taking on leadership roles to facilitate Departmental performance, as required.

These duties provide a framework for the role and should not be regarded as a definitive list. Other reasonable duties may be required consistent with the grade of the post.

What will you bring to the role?

As a Lecturer (Grade 7) in Strategy, you will have:

 A PhD in Strategic Management or a closely related discipline, or a PhD thesis that has been submitted to a doctoral assessment committee by the start date of the post;



- A clear plan for future research projects that has potential for publications in journals commensurate with a 3 and/or 4-star rating in the Academic Journal Guide of the Chartered Association of Business Schools (CABS);
- Ability and commitment to teach effectively at all levels and an enthusiastic approach to all aspects of teaching;
- Understanding of the principles of research-led teaching and a demonstrable ability to integrate research with learning and teaching to deliver an excellent student experience;
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills (oral and written);
- Talent to motivate and engender enthusiasm in others, as evidenced for example in student feedback obtained from teaching;
- Capacity to work alone or as a team effectively and responsibly, and to work under pressure.

As Lecturer (Grade 8) in Strategy, you will also have:

- Experience of obtaining research funding or the potential for obtaining it in the future;
- Publications in refereed journals commensurate with a 3 and/or 4-star rating in the Academic Journal Guide of the Chartered Association of Business Schools (CABS);
- Successful recent experience of teaching at the Masters level;
- Ability to contribute to management and administrative processes and structures, including managing resources and/or staff.
