Ability to teach in the areas of FinTech or Business Process Management will be considered a plus. The normal teaching load is eight, 3-credit classes per academic year. Participation in the life of the department, e.g., committee membership, is expected of all faculty.

The position is subject to annual renewal based on performance, and promotion to Senior Lecturer is possible after six years of service.
