#### Allocations for 2015 - 2022

The allocation considers the membership count of the previous year (as of June 30<sup>th</sup>), and is calculated as:

```
Allocation = (member count x $11) + $500

2015 allocation -> (874 members x $11) + $500 = $10,114

2016 allocation -> (893 members x $11) + $500 = $10,323

2017 allocation -> (865 members x $11) + $500 = $10,015

2018 allocation -> (837 members X$11) + $4,500 = $13,707

2019 allocation -> (866 members X$11) + $4,500 = $14,246

2020 allocation -> (866 members x$11) + 8,350 = $17,876

2021 allocation -> (803 members x$11) + 8,350** = $17,183

2022 DIG allocation withheld for FY2023 - Board of Governors' decision
