




Days of Conference Duration

- Domain Statement needs to be updated
 - Division Name should be reflective of Domain Statement
- Reframing our efforts to lead to a "Re-branding" initiative

Allocations for 2012 - 2018



The allocation considers the membership count of the previous year (as of July 1st), and is calculated as:

Allocation = (member count x $11) + $500
