### Duties

The successful candidate for the lecturer position will be expected to teach eight undergraduate and graduate course sections per year (two to three sections per semester) in Business, Society and Ethics. The successful candidate will also be expected to contribute to Beedie's teaching excellence and collaborative academic community through service.
