**Who should apply:** We welcome applications from students at any stage of their PhD program. Participation in the doctoral consortium does not prohibit you from participating in this workshop.

**Description:** This Research Development Workshop (RDW) is designed as an idea-, paper-, and dissertation-development feedback meeting for PhD students interested in technology, innovation, creativity, product development, and related topics. Students may be at any stage of a PhD program, and similarly, the ideas brought to the workshop can range from initial ideas for a paper or dissertation to fully developed papers. The workshop will feature extensive time dedicated to virtual round table conversations with faculty mentors about your submitted research ideas.
