Manuscripts must apply the NEJE's general author guidelines, such as style and paper length. We welcome newly introduced types of articles: Research Note and Practitioner Note. All papers must go through the journal's online submission portal (https://mc·manuscriptcentral·com/neje). Authors should select 'SI: New Trends in Entrepreneurship: A Global Context' option when submitting their manuscript.
